

Pool Rules

The pool rules are here to ensure safe and fun use of the pool and the pool area. They are for your own safety and must be followed. Please read them carefully:

- No glass bottles or any type of glass object
- No chewing gum
- No cigarettes, pipes, fireworks, Chinese lanterns or any type of incandescent products
- Children to be supervised at all times
- Shower before entering water
- No diving
- No running
- No climbing
- No mains powered electrical equipment
- No swimming with open wound, or skin infections
- No pets allowed in the pool or pool area
- Correct attire to be worn at all times
- No swimming if a person has had diarrhoea within the past 2 weeks
- No “horse play” around the pool area
- Always close and lock the gate behind you as you enter and leave the fenced off pool area.
- Children must not be left unsupervised when in the pool or the fenced off pool area.
- For optimal pool water temperature, always cover the pool at night.
- Over the course of the day the pool temperature should not be allowed to exceed 30 deg (see pool thermometer) if it does then the bubble cover should be left off in order to cool down the internal temperature.
- When the bubble cover is rolled up there are some securing ropes/cords. To stop it moving/unwinding when windy.
